




### Who Do you Trust?

86% of all health care professionals with a bachelor's degree or higher and who diagnose and treat patients, say they are already vaccinated (or plan to be).





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### Was This Vaccine Rushed to Market? Is It Unsafe Because It Was Developed at Warp Speed?



mRNA vaccines have been studied for decades prior to COVID-19.

Researchers used existing clinical trial networks to begin conducting COVID-19 vaccine trials.

Manufacturing started during the trials. Normally, manufacturing doesn't begin until after the trials.

mRNA vaccines are faster to produce in large amounts than traditional vaccines.



How Much Is This Going to Cost Me? Aren't the Big Pharmaceutical Companies Going to Make a Ton of Money?

The cost is \$0 for everyone, with or without insurance.

The federal government is paying for the vaccine for all Americans (this is regardless of race or ethnicity).

The vaccine provider can charge the government or an insurer for the "administration" of the vaccine, but not the patient.



### Will the Vaccine Give Me COVID-19?



None of the authorized and recommended COVID-19 vaccines currently offered in the United States contain the live virus that causes COVID-19.

This means that a COVID-19 vaccine cannot make you sick with COVID-19.

COVID-19 vaccines teach a body's immune system how to recognize and fight the virus that causes COVID-19 and sometimes this process can cause symptoms or side effects. (See slide on side effects.)

No one has contracted COVID-19 from the vaccine.



## Is my DNA being Altered by the Vaccine?



Damm Pharmacies – CPESN Kansas

mRNA-based vaccine has been studied for decades.

mRNA-based vaccine never enters the nucleus of the cell.

mRNA causes cells to make a "spike protein" that is found on the surface of the coronavirus.

The body's immune system recognizes the protein as not belonging and builds and immune response and makes antibodies.

COVID-19 vaccines do not change or interact with your DNA in any way.



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### Shouldn't I Just Use My Body's Natural Immunity Once I Contract COVID-19?



**KTA Super Stores - CPESN Hawaii** 

31,835,314 known cases of COVID-19 in the US, and 567,971 deaths.\* It is estimated that approximately 10-15% of people contracting COVID-19 become severely ill.

4,041,396 people received the first does of Moderna in the US, and 1,266 (.031%) adverse events were reported with only 108 (.0003%) being classified as severe.\*\*

1,893,360 people received the first dose of the Pfizer-BioNTech vaccine and 4,393 of them reported an adverse event (.23%), and only 175 (.0092%) of these were classified as severe.\*\*\*

You can see that becoming ill with COVID-19 is far more dangerous than getting an mRNA vaccine.



### Were All Races a Part of the Clinical Trials?



All COVID-19 clinical trials recruited a diverse mix of participants.

Here are the percentages:

- Pfizer 45,301 people 70% white, 13% Hispanic, 10% Black, 6% Asian, 1% Native American
- Moderna 30,000 people 63% white, 20% Hispanic, 10% Black, 4% Asian, 3% other non-white
- Janssen 40,000 people 62% white, 17% Black, 8% Native, 4% Asian, 5% multiple races. (45% of all participants were Hispanic)

There were no significant safety concerns identified in these or any other groups.



### What About the Side Effects? How Severe Are They?



There are side effects of the COVID-19 vaccines consistent with symptoms of the infection.

Common ones:

- In the shoulder/arm redness, pain, swelling
- Others Headache, muscle pain, tiredness, chills, fever, nausea

Side effects should last just a couple days.

Some side effects are just normal signs that your body is building a defense against COVID-19.
