- The SLC is comprised of 16 student members who each serve a two-year term.
 - Eight members are appointed each year.
- Only one student may be appointed from the same school or college of pharmacy per year.

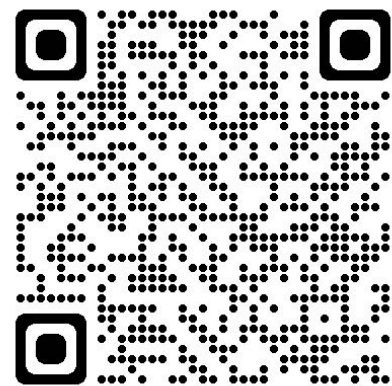

SUMMER INTERNSHIP

- The NCPA summer intern spends 10 weeks at NCPA Headquarters beginning in May or June.
- Acquire an in-depth understanding of issues and opportunities facing independent community pharmacy practice and broaden understanding of the importance of national pharmacy associations to the profession.
- Gain up to 350 internship hours toward licensure, depending upon your state's regulations.
- Receive a competitive stipend to help offset living expenses while in Alexandria, VA.
- Application available at ncpa.org/internships-and-rotations and is due by Dec. 31.

APPE ROTATION

- The experiential rotation is aligned to school block rotation dates and is available year-round.
- Work in a variety of departments within NCPA.
- Long-term projects are designed to meet the student's rotation goals.
- Two rotation students are accepted per block
- Application available at ncpa.org/internships-and-rotations and is due by Dec. 31.

EXECUTIVE RESIDENCY

The NCPA Executive Residency is a springboard into a career of association work or independent practice that will provide you with distinction as a future leader in the health care field.

- Conducted at NCPA Headquarters in Alexandria, VA.
- Gain experience in association management through involvement with the NCPA Innovation Center and contributions to the departments of Strategic Initiatives, Government Affairs, Membership, and Conventions.
- One-year term beginning July 1. Some travel expected.
- Application available at ncpa.org/resident and is due by Dec. 31.
