What does LDF do?

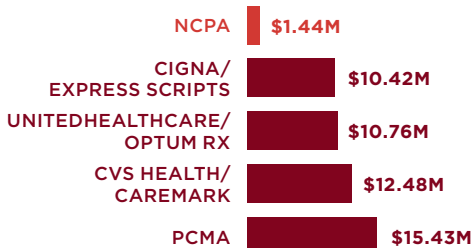
The LDF **funds** NCPA's **federal and state government affairs** activities **on your behalf**.

Running an **effective** legislative and regulatory affairs program can be **quite costly**.



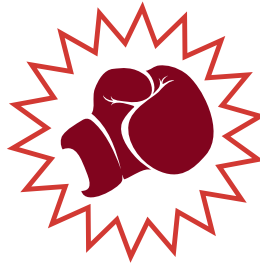
A **fully-funded** government affairs operation **is necessary to keep the tide turning** in our favor and can cost over **\$3 million** a year.

The health care industry alone spent **\$745,396,217** on lobbying in 2023.



Despite being outspent, NCPA and the grassroots efforts of members **have advanced PBM reform initiatives across all branches of government**.

From Congress to the courts and from the state house to the White House, the NCPA LDF is fighting for your pharmacy. The LDF funds NCPA's involvement in court cases, public awareness campaigns, and grassroots engagement while supporting NCPA's federal and state government affairs activities.



NCPA **needs a well-funded LDF** to fight back against the **PBM's deep pockets**.

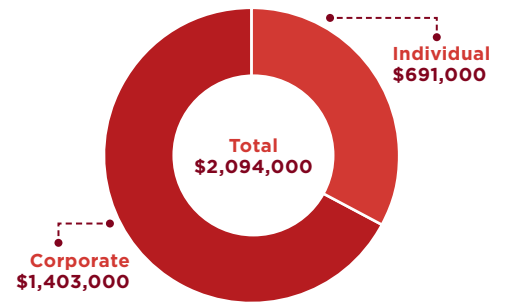
Community pharmacy is subject to pervasive federal regulation. **The government plays the leading role** in reimbursement policy for Medicare and Medicaid patients.
