New additions to the rubric:

In the case of a tie, we have introduced a new stipulation for sections marked with an asterisk. These sections will now include an 'or more' clause in the quantification of grading. This allows chapters to specify how many additional activities or achievements they have accomplished beyond the standard requirements. If a tie occurs for the Chapter of the Year or Most Improved Chapter of the Year awards, these additional details will be reviewed to potentially award bonus points and break any ties.
